



### Signal lights for Jaffna streets

Traditional Industries and Small Enterprise Development Minister and EPDP Secretary General Douglas Devananda has taken steps to set up signal lights in the streets within the Jaffna Municipal limit similar to the Singapore standards as one of the planned development works.

**Commercial Development Director Samarajeeva Alwis and Engineer Keerthi Subramaniam of A.T.T. system Group of Singapore had a meeting with the Minister at his Jaffna office in this regard.**

In accordance with this discussion signal lights with modern technology is to be put in the Jaffna streets in order to control the traffic congestion similarly to Singapore.

This project is to be implemented in three stages. 100 lights are to be installed in the first stage on the priority basis and the rest of the lights will be installed in the other two stages. Modern cameras are also to be installed.

This entire project will be controlled from the Central Operating Centre. The infrastructure works of this project is to commence in the mid of this year and is to be completed by 2014.

The copies of the draft of this project were handed over to the Minister and Jaffna Mayoress Yogeswary Patkunarahah. Road Development Authority, Jaffna District Chief Engineer Suthakar and City Traffic Police participated in this discussion.
